

## **GGGC BRS Tee-Time Booking Procedures for 2012**

Following the presentation on the website of the BRS Tee-Time booking roadmap for Glen Gorse GC in 2012, I am now in a position to present the arrangements and implementation plans for the development of the system to you, as these have now been discussed and agreed by Council on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2011.

The extension of the system for casual golf is being implemented initially on a trial basis in 2012, and may be subject to later amendment if appropriate.

Please note that tee-time booking for members is not compulsory at any point during the day, but all tee-times booked on the BRS system will have priority on the tee.

The daily casual play timesheets will automatically open for electronic bookings to members 15 days before the due calendar date at 07:00am. All players who have booked a time on the system must report to the Professionals Shop to confirm attendance before playing the course.

### **Casual Play/General Golf**

**Mon-Fri: January 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup> 2012:** The BRS tee-time booking system will open Mon-Fri from 11:30am for those members who wish to book a tee-time. Before 11:30am the course is available for members who do not wish to book a tee-time.

**Sat-Sun: January 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup> 2012:** The BRS tee-time booking system will not be used for weekend tee-time bookings.

**Mon-Fri: April 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup> 2012:** The BRS tee-time booking system will open Mon-Fri from 2:00pm for those members who wish to book a tee-time. Before 2:00pm the course is available for members who do not wish to book a tee-time.

**Sat-Sun: April 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup> 2012:** The BRS tee-time booking system will open Sat-Sun from 09:00am for those members who wish to book a tee-time. Before 09:00am the course is available for members who do not wish to book a tee-time.

### **Visitors and GGGC Open Competitions Online Booking**

The Council have passed the proposal to purchase the BRS Visitors and Open Competitions booking module which will be implemented in January 2012. This will allow visitors, golf societies and members to book and pay for, those tee-times allocated for visitors and all GGGC Open Competitions.

The BRS system will be closely monitored and administered throughout 2012 to ensure its effectiveness in securing the continuing appropriate efficiencies for the club's members and visitors.
