DRESS CODE

Smart golfing clothing is required at all times

MEN Course and Clubhouse	LADIES Course and Clubhouse
HEADGEAR Must be appropriate to golf and worn the correct way round. Headgear must be removed in the Clubhouse.	HEADGEAR Must be appropriate to golf and worn the correct way round. Headgear must be removed in the Clubhouse.
SHIRTS Should be designed for golf and have a collar or turtleneck with long or short sleeves. May be worn outside trousers or shorts if so designed. Collarless/tee/singlets/sleeveless or shirts with non Golf LOGO are not permitted.	SHIRTS Shirts will usually have a collar, or may be without if specifically designed for golf. Must cover the waistband of shorts. Tee shirts or shirts with non Golf LOGO are not permitted
TROUSERS Trousers must be tailored and ankle length unless plus 2's or plus 4's. Denim wear, combat/cargo type trousers, shell suits, tracksuits or visible braces are not permitted. Trousers must NOT to be tucked into socks.	TROUSERS Trousers, whether ankle or ¾ length, must be tailored. Denim wear, combat/cargo type trousers, shell suits and tracksuits are not permitted. Trousers must NOT be tucked into socks.
SHORTS AND SOCKS Shorts must be tailored and designed for golf. Short white socks must be visible. When wearing shorts long socks may be of any colour. Beach type, football, rugby, athletic, combat/ cargo shorts are NOT permitted.	SHORTS AND SOCKS Shorts/skirts must be tailored, designed for golf and with a hem no higher than 6 inches above the knee. Short sports socks [white or coloured to co-ordinate with clothing] will be worn at all times and must be visible. Beach type, sports, combat/ cargo type shorts are NOT permitted.
FOOTWEAR Golf shoes must be worn on the course. Soft spikes are preferred during summer months. JUNIORS ONLY may wear trainers in the Stud Bar area. Golf shoes, socks [without shoes], flip flops or bare feet are NOT acceptable in the Clubhouse.	FOOTWEAR Golf shoes must be worn on the course. Soft spikes are preferred during summer months. JUNIORS ONLY may wear trainers in the Stud Bar area. Golf shoes, socks [without shoes] or bare feet are NOT acceptable in the Clubhouse.
DINING ROOM Jacket, collar and tie unless otherwise stipulated. Members will be expected to change from their golf attire and be suitably dressed for receiving their prize at Club Presentations.	DINING ROOM Smart attire with formal shoes or sandals, unless otherwise stipulated. Members will be expected to change from their golfing attire, and be suitably dressed, for receiving their prize at Club Presentations.

MOBILE PHONES

May only be used outside the Clubhouse and on the car-park.

May NOT be used on the COURSE [except in an emergency] or in the Clubhouse.

Management Staff and Committee Members of G.G.G.C. have full authority to use their discretion in enforcing this dress code, anyone contravening the Dress Code will be asked to leave the course/ Clubhouse.
